- This is a non-juried event open to all A&C Members; memberships must be in good standing for the run of the show.

- Paintings, works on paper, mixed media, digital art, photography, sculpture, and fine craft will be accepted.
- Participating artists may each submit 2 pieces; additional work may be accepted if initial pieces are sold.
- It is understood that artist's images may be used for promotional purposes.

SALES

- Artists will collect 100% of the profits from the sale of their work during the run of the exhibition; the A&C will not charge a commission.
- Artists will be responsible for handling every aspect of their transactions, including processing of payment, shipping, delivery, customer service, etc. Please keep this in mind when establishing prices.

- Ads in Bucks County Herald, digital and print; listings in online event calendars; promotion through social media; prominently featured on A&C Website.

SPECIFICATIONS

- Artists must submit high res images properly prepared. (Cropped, not crooked, high quality - no larger than 5 MG file size)
- All images submitted to ruanderson4@gmail.com must be clearly identified with the following REQUIRED information:
 - o Artist's name (to appear in the exhibition; please check your spelling!)
 - o Artist's Mailing Address
 - o Artist's Email
 - o Artist's Phone (in the event there is a problem or question)
 - o Title of work (please check your spelling!)
 - o Medium
 - o Dimensions
 - o Framed/Unframed
 - o Price (see SALES)
 - o Artist's website, if applicable
 - o Interest in A&C Facebook Live (see OUTREACH)
 - o Proof of Entry Fee payment
