It is through this meaningful collaboration and a shared commitment to the importance of arts and artists that the A&C Community Meeting Center is becoming a reality.

Art exhibition opportunities and more

The Community Meeting Center will provide the Arts & Cultural Council and all of its members with ongoing exhibition and event spaces and an upstairs meeting room.

Throughout the main floor, A&C programs at Freeman Hall will further engage artist members and the Bucks County community in regularly scheduled educational initiatives, provide venues for meaningful arts and advocacy dialogue, and strengthen local and regional arts awareness through exhibition and sale opportunities, events, performances, workshops, and forums.

A room to call our own

In our second-floor meeting room the A&C will host more intimate Art Shares, portfolio reviews, Coffee and Conversation, and more, with hours and services available to members on an ongoing basis.

Our Community Meeting Center at Freeman Hall will be featured on our new website. The move in date is currently up in the air, as you can imagine. We have agreed to abide by state and borough guidelines in relation to stay at home regulations. First and foremost is our shared concern for the health and safety of the community; to that end, we will err on the side of caution. Looking forward, we realize that the Arts & Cultural Council has many, many years to establish a successful Community Meeting Center at Freeman Hall.
