Requirements

- **Register online at www.bucksarts.org/enter by end of day September 7, 2021**
- **Drop off September 8, 3-7 pm** at Freeman Hall located at 181 East Court Street, Doylestown.
- **Show Dates** Saturday, September 11 and Sunday, September 12 from 10 am to 5 pm (During Doylestown Arts Festival)
Friday, September 17, September 24 and October 1 from 5 to 7 pm
Saturday, September 18 and September 25 from 11 am to 7 pm
Sunday, September 19 and September 26 from noon to 4 pm
Other hours by appointment
- A&C member artists may submit **two artworks – no entry fee**. This is a member-benefit exhibit opportunity.
- A&C member artists may submit 2D works in any medium. *(Due to space constraints during this informal exhibition, we can only accept wall-hanging sculpture pieces (up to 8 lb. weight) and are not able to display floor/tabletop sculptures; they will always be included in our more formal shows.)*
- **A&C will accept up to 120 pieces** for the exhibition. **Registrations will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.** Some artists may have one piece displayed on the second floor.
- **Participating artists are required to register at www.bucksarts.org/enter by September 7, 2021**
- Size limit for all art should **not exceed 16" X 20"**, exclusive of frame.
- Artists' name, phone number, email address, website (if available), title, medium, and price **must be on the back of all pieces**.
- All hanging works **must be wired for hanging** or will be declined upon delivery; NO sawtooth hangers.
- Artists are invited to bring promotional literature (postcards, business cards, etc.) for the A&C to make available to visitors to the exhibit. We will also feature this literature in our booth at the Doylestown Arts Festival.
- Participating artists must agree to commit to one 2-hour gallery sitting time slot.
- Regional artists who are not currently A&C members are encouraged to join now and take advantage of this exhibition opportunity. Learn more at bucksarts.org.

Standard label for artwork

- Artwork will be labeled in the Freeman Hall galleries.
- All artwork will be labeled with Artists' Name, Contact Information, Title, Medium, and Price.

Sales

- Artists will receive 80% of the proceeds from the sale of any artwork. The remaining 20% will support the Arts & Cultural Council of Bucks County.
- Buyers will purchase work directly through the artists, and artists will submit the 20% commission to the A&C within 2 weeks of the sale date. Checks should be made payable to the Arts & Cultural Council of Bucks County and mailed to: Arts & Cultural Council of Bucks County, c/o Arts Department BCCC, 275 Swamp Road, Newtown PA 18940.

Liability

- I understand that the A&C exhibition space at Freeman Hall will be used by artist tenants and Salem Church for occasional events during the exhibition.
- The work I am submitting for A&C FALL SALON MEMBERS SHOW at FREEMAN HALL is the possession and responsibility of the artist. While the Arts & Cultural Council of Bucks County and Freeman Hall at Salem will do their best to protect the work of art, they are not liable for any damages and/or theft that may come to the work while on display. I also understand that I/the artist am/is may be responsible for picking up selected first-floor work at the close of the exhibition on **October 2**; the remainder of the work on **November 3**. The Arts & Cultural Council of Bucks County and Freeman Hall at Salem will be unable to store work after that date.
- Any works submitted to the A&C FALL SALON MEMBERS SHOW at FREEMAN HALL may be photographed, and photographs may be used by the Arts & Cultural Council of Bucks County and Freeman Hall at Salem for video, website, internet, publicity, films, social media, and Arts & Cultural Council of Bucks County and Freeman Hall at Salem publications. I understand that the artist's name may be used in conjunction with the images. I also understand that the Arts & Cultural Council of Bucks County and Freeman Hall at Salem will not share these images with any other institution or organization for their use without prior permission.
